**COMPANY DESCRIPTION**

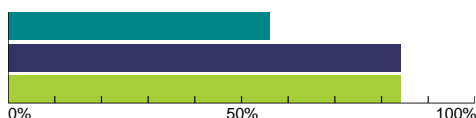
Companhia Energética de Minas Gerais is one of the largest electric energy utility companies in Brazil. It primarily generates, transmits and distributes electricity. The company is also engaged in gas distribution, telecommunications and consulting through its subsidiaries. CEMIG operates 53 hydroelectric plants, four thermoelectric plants and one wind farm, with a total installed capacity of 6,580 MW. As of 31 December 2009, it owned and operated ~3,000 miles of transmission lines and ~280,000 miles of distribution lines. In 2009, CEMIG expects to start its first foreign electricity distribution operations in Chile. In February 2009, the company entered into a share purchase agreement with Energimp S.A. for a 49 percent stake in three wind farms - UEE Praia do Morgado, UEE Praias de Parajurú and UEE Volta do Rio. In July 2009, the company acquired a 95 percent stake in Brookfield Incorporacoes SA, which has interests in other electricity utilities such as Empresa Amazonense de Transmissao de Energia SA- EATE and Empresa Paraense de Transmissao de Energia SA ETEP.

**SUSTAINABILITY PERFORMANCE**

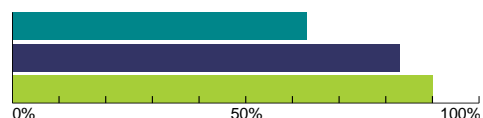
Cia Energetica Minas Gerais (CEMIG) is a long standing member of the DJSI World. The company's impressive performance has once again made it the industry leader. The company launched 'Minas Small Hydroelectric Plant Program' in March 2009 with an objective to leverage the development and expansion of regional markets and capitalise on existing market opportunity for hydroelectric energy. Along with this, CEMIG has tapped potential market opportunities by investing in projects utilising renewable energy sources especially biomass, solar energy and wind-electric generation plants. CEMIG has a well-developed scorecard measurement system to benchmark performance with indicators of customer satisfaction, innovation etc. The company has illustrated its sensitivity towards environment by investing in projects aimed at rational use of energy, co-generation and distributed generation. The company also focuses enhancing interaction with stakeholders, therefore, in 2008 created a project called Cemig 2.0, to leverage the benefits of Web 2.0 applications.

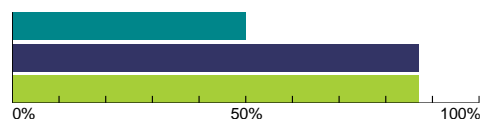

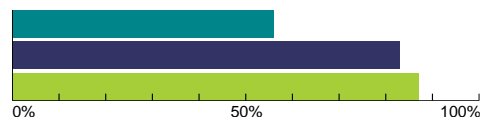

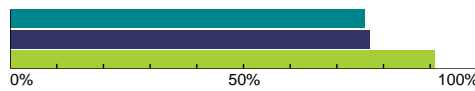
**INDUSTRY DRIVING FORCES**

The liberalisation of electricity markets, increasing attention to global warming and growing demand for energy in emerging economies are reshaping the landscape of electric utilities globally. Regulation and environmental issues are likely to remain at the top of utility boardroom agendas. For companies in this sector, these trends give rise to the growing demand for cleaner, renewable and distributed energy, while enabling diversification of fuel sources and energy services. As such, electric utilities have a responsibility to enhance both supply-side and demand-side energy efficiency as a key component of reducing environmental impacts. At the same time, electricity companies are faced with increased competition and price volatility, greenhouse gas emissions from carbon-intensive power generation, and potential opposition to large infrastructure projects. Despite its low carbon profile, nuclear power remains exposed to public scrutiny, investment and decommissioning costs, and nuclear waste disposal.

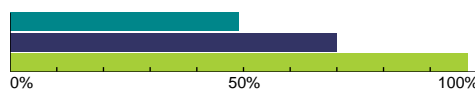
